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
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



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






















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Instructor Notes

The following page can be used along with <u>Weird Al's "Word Crimes"</u> <u>video</u>. After watching the video, students make a note of all the different word crimes mentioned in the song, and then make a top ten list of the worst. They can also add in any that were not mentioned in the song.

For each line, students write a brief description of the "crime" (type of error), for example, your/you're confusion. Then on the line next to it, they write an example of a sentence using that error. (e.g. Is this you're dog?"

This activity can be done without using the video, but it may be difficult for some students to think of enough errors on their own to make a top ten list.
